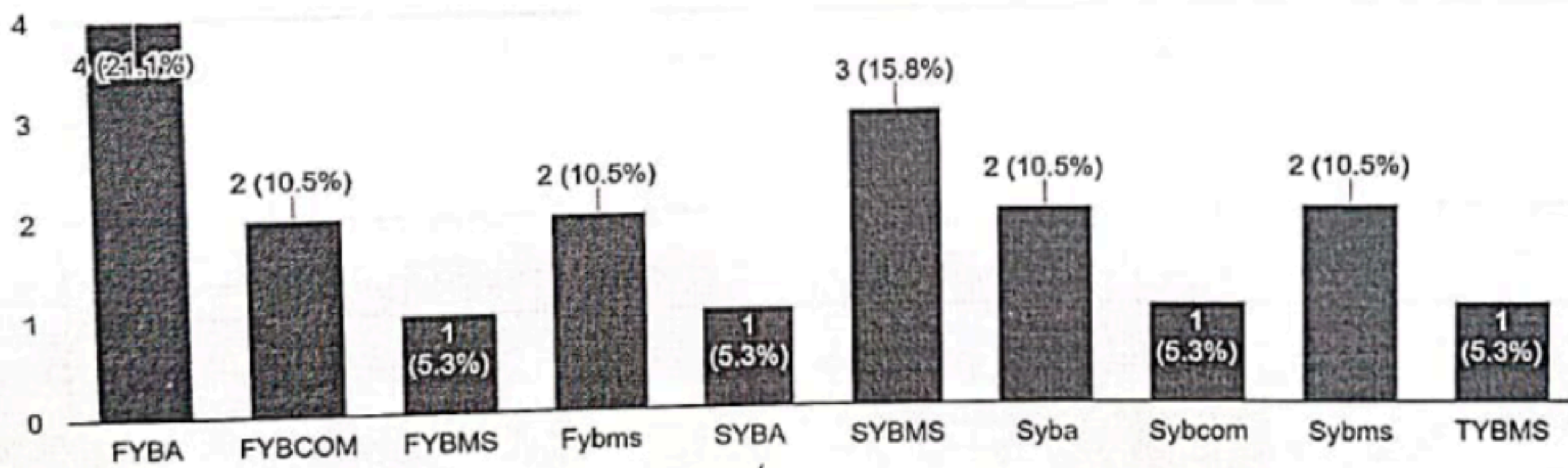

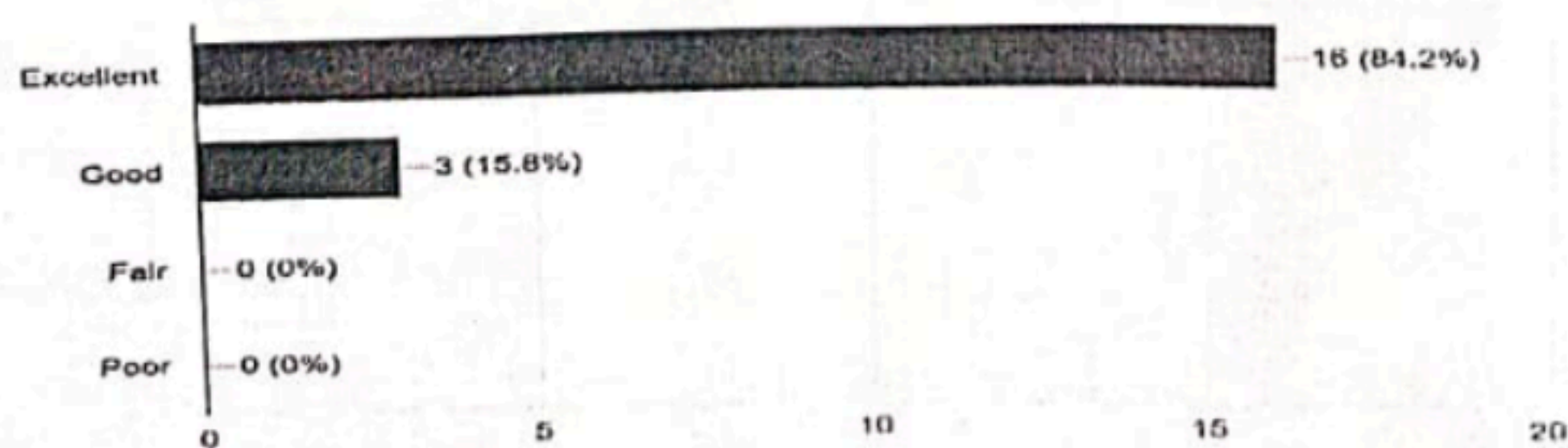

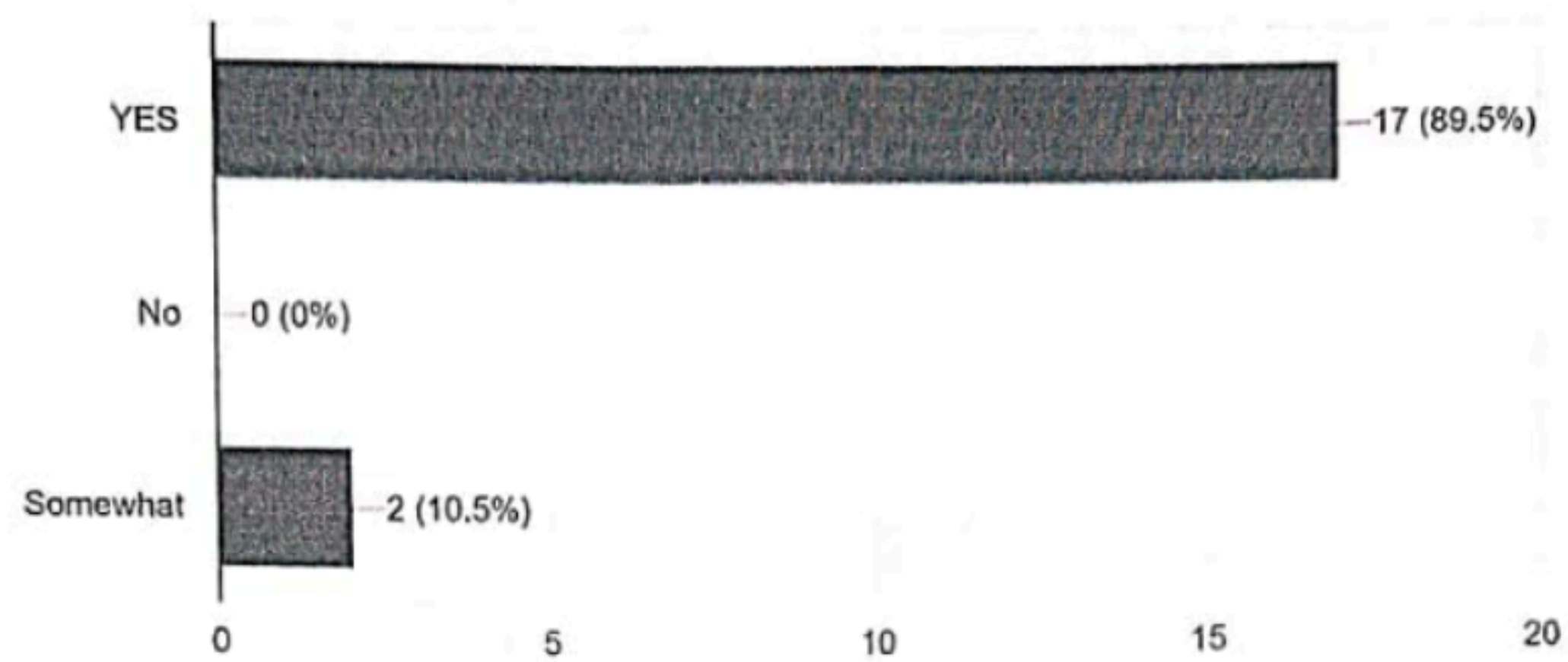
How would you rate the overall experience of the visit?

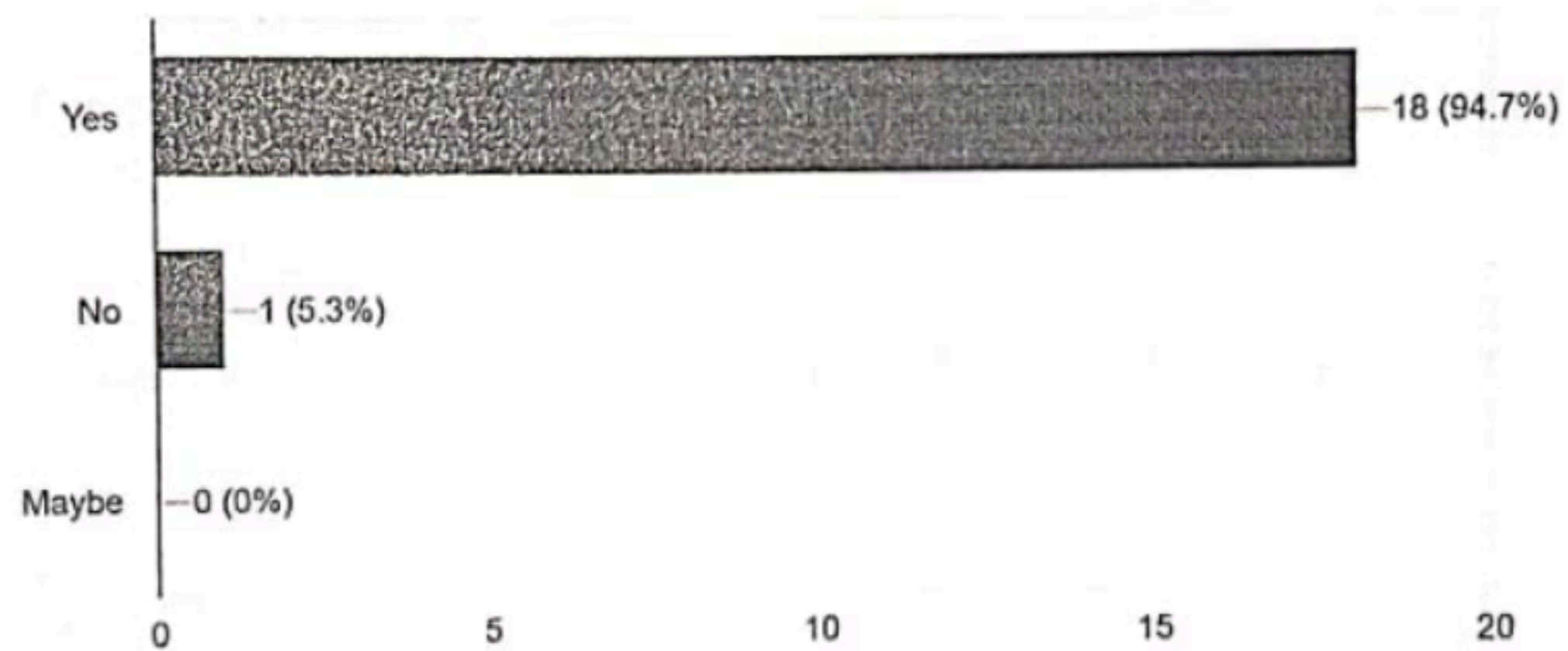

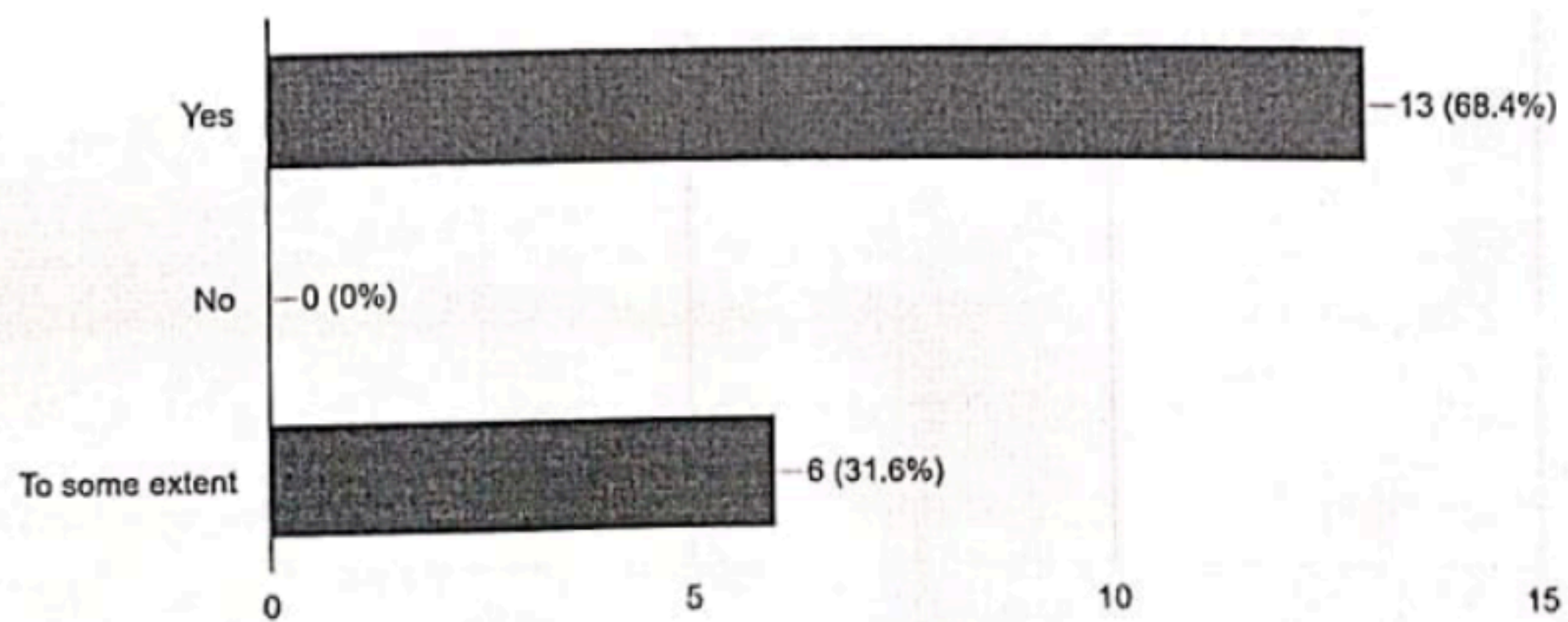

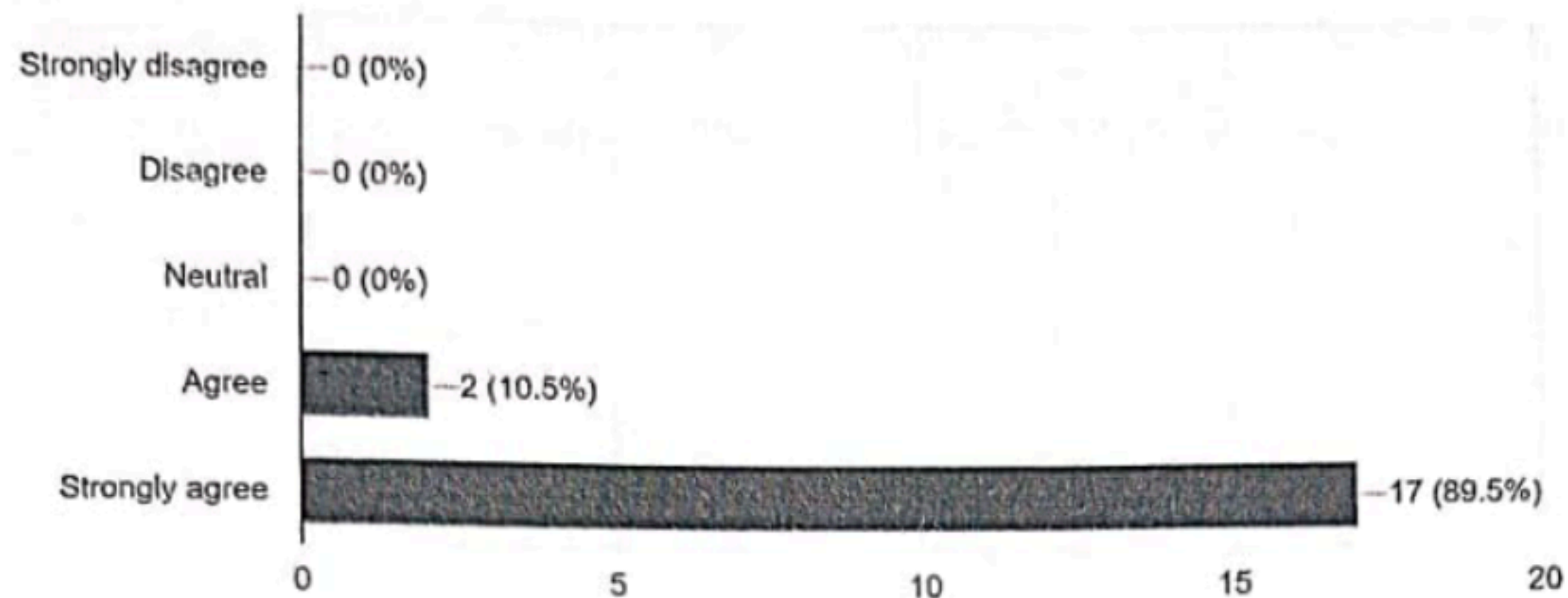
